## THE VENUES

Most venues are in Swanage High Street, so if you start off from the pier, the first venues are the **East Bar** and **Bar Se7en** (1 High St), **White Horse** (11), **Ship, Swanage** (23a), **White Swan** (The Square), **Anchor Inn** (30), **Red Lion** (63), and the **Black Swan** (159).

**Swanage Railway Station** is in the centre of the town. The **Bankes Arms Hotel** is in East Street, Corfe Castle - Swanage Railway runs there, but check train times carefully.

The **Crow's Nest** is 11 Ulwell Rd – from the town centre, go along Shore Road (with the bay on your right) and at Ocean Bay restaurant bear left up the hill. From the Crow's Nest, go over the road into Burlington Rd for the **Grand Hotel**.
