Look, there is plenty to be cheerful about. The snow has gone, and your patio isn't on fire. True, the money in the bank might not be as much as you thought, but think of all the great music that came out of the American Depression. Well you can at least cheer yourself by getting out there and enjoying some excellent acts.

"This month will see the release of Bournemouth's very own local Comic Relief charity single. Spear-headed by local musician, song-writer, and producer Adam Scholey, 'BournemouthAID' will release a collaborative cover of the Slade classic "Mama Weer All Crazee Now" featuring local bands and artists from a range of genres - including Si Genaro, Alex Roberts, Lawrence Case (Voodoo Vegas), Tris Palumbo (Club Le Shark), Dale Scholey & Matt Grainger (...And The Magical 8-Ball Band), Zac Harris, Richie Adams (Hoffman Sloth), Ant Henson (Undercurrent /The Doggy B-Sides), and Dean Scholey (Damnation Alley). CDs will be on sale from selected shops around the Bournemouth/Poole area as of Saturday 7th March to coincide with this year's BBC Comic Relief Red Nose Day (Friday 13th). One of the most uplifting gigs I have been to in recent times was an unpublished event at the Gander. The Tyla Gang was warming up prior to a tour, and had invited a few friends over for a bit of a party. Here was the front man of those Boogie champions "Ducks Delux" with Howard Gillespie (of Oasis Music, in Ringwood) playing some cracking guitar. Old school bluesy Americana, glorious off the wall modern country... I left with tunes in my head and a copy of the CD "Back in the Saddle" in my pocket. What a brilliant band. Can't wait for their new album, released later in the year, prior to The Tyla Gang touring Europe. Amazingly, when they play at Mr. Kyps, admission is free! I'll be in the audience, on Thursday 12th. See you there.

Another gem at Kyps this month, "Keith James and Rick Foot celebrate New York's abundant musical and poetic history with a new album and concert tour of unique and evocative music featuring material by Leonard Cohen, Federico Garcia Lorca, Vladimir Nabokov, Laura Nyro, Bob Dylan, Suzanne Vega, and Pablo Neruda." "Genuinely Inspirational" BBC Manchester. Mr. Kyps (In the Round) 15th March.

Local Boy makes good... James Parker has the voice, the songs and the attitude. He has already supported Ian Parker, Derrin Nauendorf, and Bob Dylan. Blimey! He also has a tour which takes in the Tivoli on March 7th. The ticket sales for his performances have been tremendous and have resulted in sell out gigs. His band includes the brilliant Scott McKeon, who co produced the new album, "I'm Here". Check out some of the songs www.myspace.com/jamesparker. There's an incredible variety to James Parker's material. He gets a phenomenal number of plays a day on myspace, well I've been listening to "this Ain't Right" over and over again. Rare chance to see Bournemouth's own contribution to Pro Rock, when Galahad appear at The Thomas Tripp in Christchurch on March 22nd. They have a enviable back catalogue of CDs, and an equally enviable international fan base... Highly Recommended .

Incidentally, Galahad has had airplay on BBC Radio 1, and at least two dozen US radio stations, plus stations in such far flung places as Argentina, Brazil, Peru, Turkey, Japan, Israel, Indonesia, Poland, Latvia to name but a few. Amazingly they have never appeared on our local radio. Now I know that Live Wire is read by people in the local radio stations. Come on you guys, how about it?

Other highlights in the Tripp fleet of venues..

The Tripp Late has Guns 2 Roses , regarded as the best GNR tribute, even winning the approval of the original band. They have appeared on the BBC, several times including A Question of Sport and headlined Glastonbudget Festival three times. Surely the greatest highlight this year was being featured on Channel 5's fifth gear, appropriate, as this is a tribute to Top Gear.

Another Replica band appearing is Simple Minds – "The World's premier tribute to Simple Minds. With a wealth of great Simple Minds material to choose from including – 'Don't You Forget About Me', 'Alive and Kicking' and 'Belfast Child' – Expect all the hits in a breathtaking 2 hour performance!"

Check out Hipfandango at The Lymington Branch, another local band with incredible potential... and they've got Derrin Nauendorf here on 22nd

Swanage Blues Festival is on this month. You get free admission to all venues with 40 gigs in fifteen indoor venues. There are Open Mic sessions every afternoon at The Red Lion, plus Jam Sessions at the White Horse with the Robin Bibi Band. Go to www.swanage-blues.org for more info.

There's more good Blues Jamming going on at The Bournebeat Hotel in Bournemouth on the 11th, and of course, The Producers return here on the 19th after their sell-out gig last month.

The Cricketers In Windham Road now has regular folk sessions on the second Wednesday of each month. The Folk Club that used to congregate at the Ship in Christchurch, moved here last month, and really took to the friendly atmosphere.

Three highly respected local musicians have come together to form The Mercury Men. Simon Johnson and Gavin Wyatt were first to be seen in the band Filite, and Jinder could be found in local pubs pedalling his acoustic set . They all collided in a recording studio, laying down some vocal harmonies for a friend. Something clicked. What has emerged is a superb and brilliant group that has caused heads to turn in a cynical music scene. Simon Johnson is one of the most natural guitar players I know. We have watched Jinder's vocal talents develop and blossom, from teenage angst, to mature excellence. I remember taking a friend of mine to see Filite in the early days. When Gavin sang he said, "How can he possibly sing like that? He's too young!" They have taken their time perfecting their new album. It is exceptionally good, great harmonies, beautiful writing, brilliant musicianship. They have been compared to Crowded House and Crosby, Stills, Nash & Young. They have supported Sinead O'Connor and Deacon Blue, Level 42 and more. They are signed to RCA/Sony. Their debut Album "Postcards From Valonia" is superb. Catch the Mercury men while you can. Soon, you will have to pay big bucks to see them. Catch them at The Rydal, New Milton on March 22nd.

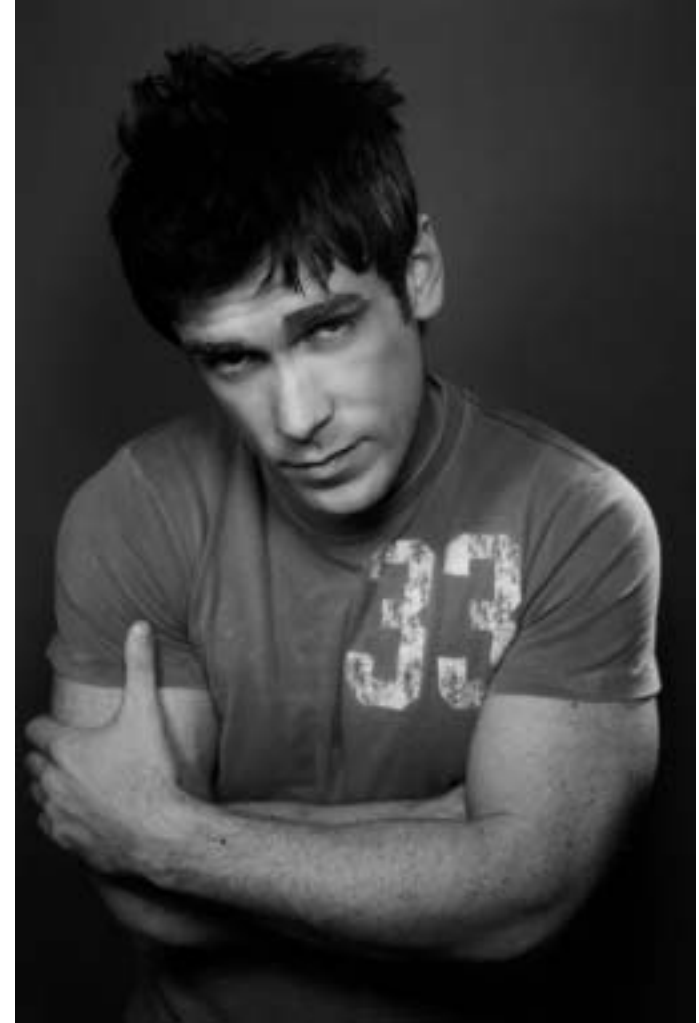
