Have enjoyed live music in all of these venues and indeed played in all of them, but Mr. C's.

I met a group of Jazz Funk musicians from Plymouth not long ago who said they were going to try to get a gig at Mr. Smiths. At the same event were members of a Winchester Indie band who's ambition was to play at Smiths. I had to break the news that this venue closed a long time ago.
I, like many others, still miss this place.

But lets not get disheartened. The Bell in Pokesdown now has Live Music. Chaplin's and the Cellar Bar seem to be going from strength th strength. Every thing from The Pink Moon Acoustic Sessions, to Reggae, Blues, and now some excellent regular jazz has been added to the mix!
The Bournebeat shows great promise. They had an excellent Blues Jam here, in January, the first of a regular monthly event. The first gig of the reformed and renewed Producers was glorious. Tickets went very quickly. If you missed out you will get another chance next month. You can order your tickets for The Producers, 19th March, and/or the the Rod Demick gig 18th Feb by contacting Dave Saunders at davesau@ntl.com, or from the venue.

Rod Demick is, of course, the guitarist who plays with Paul Lamb and the King Snakes, one of the really great British Blues outfits. This truly remarkable band is at The Tripp Late & Live, in Christchurch on Saturday 28th. *"Simply better than the opposition from whatever side of the Atlantic they come"...* *Blueprint. "They play blues in the same way Brando used to straddle a Triumph, lazily, cocksure, coolly and aggressive" ...Blues & Rhythm. "Sounds as American and black as Brits dare" (Melody Maker). Excellent stuff.*

Beyond Belief have changed their name to Brass Monkey, same line up, new singer, new set; Fevertree have changed their name to Blackwater Junction. Meanwhile, Norwich Union has become Aviva, dunno why, and Permanent Vacation are beginning the gradual metamorphosis to become "PV".....

The Manor Arms is, despite rumours to the contrary, is open and rocking. In this friendly venue you will find a wide variety of music ranging from Sublime Swing, and Trad Jazz from John Maddocks Jazzmen, to classic rock from Permanent Vacation, (soon to be known as PV), Q.E.D., The Mafia, Balance of Power and more, not to mention Lady Winwood's Maggot, so I won't mention them. I understand the Maggots are looking for a permanent mandolin player, as they wore the last one out. If you have completed the "Bert Weedon Play The Mandolin In A Day" book, and think you can fit the bill, call 07742 396990. Will you have to play mandolin down the phone? I do hope so.

Amongst the Highlights at Kyps this month is the glamorous and talented Imelda May. She wowed them at Gastonbury, and knocked 'em dead supporting Jools Holland on his recent tour. Her music is an infused concoction of rockabilly, country, and blues, with a pinch of jazziness. There will be a mixture of self penned numbers interspersed with her own spin on some classic standards, all topped with an incredible sassy stage presence. Supporting Imelda is the excellent Black Bart. The choice of this band for this gig is inspired. Black Bart is a very impressive new wave country band. Tight, enthusiastic, and brilliant. This gig is a superb double bill. Get there early, and enjoy. Mr. Kyps Thursday 26th February. And the legendary Ruby Turner is here on the 21st!

Solid Air was born 8 years and 5 months ago at Bartonka, 39, Poole Hill, Bournemouth. This place is now known as the Winchester, and Solid Air, are back home.

This band of alleged rouges arrive at The Old Fire Station, in Holdenhurst Road, on Tuesday 3rd February. NOISE LIMITERS
It has been brought to our attention that new noise legislation is about to be introduced and is likely to virtually destroy live music in the UK. The government wish to consider it a legal requirement in the new tax year to introduce laws insisting anyone applying or re-applying for an entertainment licence must have a noise control device fitted to the venue. This will be the final nail in the coffin for pretty much ALL entertainment in the UK as the level at which these devices cut the power off is ridiculously low. In our experience any venue that has one in use cannot have any electric music as the power is constantly being cut mid-song, and even loud applause at the end of a song can cut it. Venues are suffering enough as it is without being forced to go to the expense of fitting one of these damned things. Noise limiters are a menace to live music, and we expect this is the bright idea of some unelected suit in Brussels that's never been to a gig in their life. Bloody politicians - why can't they all just ***** off and let us lead our lives?
