After waking up America on their recent tour they now have Bournemouth firmly in their sights. Now, you might be thinking that your mother would not like this band. However, she might be digging out the Doc Martins and bondage trousers and heading to Champions on Thursday 4th. Go, enjoy. Just don't walk up to Animal, and tell him he's a pussy, really... The bill includes support from **The Gutter Rats**. This inglorious event is brought to you by **The Armadillo Club**, as part of their ongoing program of classic Punk.

Michael Roach came into this world in Washington D.C. in 1955. It was not until his late twenties that he bought his first guitar, but eventually he was mentored by the likes of John Jackson, and John Cephas, old time blues and folk musicians, players who were a direct link with an earlier blues tradition. The more veteran players he met, the more he imbibed in their music and style, until now he is an ambassador for this rich culture. Eventually he settled in Britain, in the Cotswolds, in fact. He is a continuation of this inheritance. It is a joy to experience one of Michael Roach's gigs. The African Soul Rebels UK Tour comes to the Lighthouse in Poole this month. Oumou Sangare is one of the biggest stars in Mali, a towering, regal diva whose uncompromising lyrics in praise of women have made her the funkiest feminist icon on the planet. *"If Aretha Franklin had grown up in Bamako she might have sounded something like this"*. (BBC Music). On their first tour of Britain, after 45 years together, Benin's Orchestre Poly-Rythmo are the undisputed heavyweights of voodoo rock. Completing the line-up with a dystopian urban groove are South Africa's Kalahari Surfers and their special guests, the dub poet, Lesego Rampolokeng.

Oli Brown and his band had been turning heads on both sides of the Atlantic. He has already produced a stunning album, "Open Road". He formed his band in March 2007, and performed on the Paul Jones Show on Radio 2 two months later. Oli's trips to the States have seen him sharing the bill with the likes of Sherman Robinson, Jon Cleary, Johnny Winter, The Fabulous, Thunderbirds, Robin Ford, Walter Trout and Devon Allman. He took part in the Blues Caravan Tour in 2009. All this and he's only 19 years old! As Classic Rock says, Oli "has the Blues under his Fingernails"...They also described him as "One of the best and brightest guitar heroes performing in the world today". "A real talent... should have a great career " Joe Bonamassa: " I am a big fan of this boy" Walter Trout. When he appears at **Bournemouth Blues Club**. Champions, on Monday 1st he will be supported by the excellent Reptiles. Do not miss.

John James Newman returns to the Rydal Arms on Sunday 14th February. He is, of course, the front-man of the highly acclaimed **Velvet Hearts**, and, along with his song writing partner Steve Jones, has penned some brilliant songs, noted for their emotion, and killer hooks. His energetic solo performances are full of energy, and his guitar playing is sublime. The Rydal also plays host to "Armchair Oracle", a Norwegian pop outfit currently touring Britain. Apparently one of the members is from Lymington. You can check them out on Saturday 20th. Add to this bands like The Blackberry Jam Band, and the incomparable Lady Winwood's Maggot, and we have another strong program from this New Milton venue.

The Bournebeat based **Bournemouth Rock & Roll Club** is now being coordinated by Billy Ko & Lynn Sharman. Billy's connection with the local Rock 'n' Roll scene goes back over 25 years when he used to organise nights at The Midnight Express Club. Another great line up of rocking band for this month. Friday Nights at the Bournebeat feature The **Rhythm Cats**, **The Blue Beats**, **Outrage** and **Ogri** and the **Cafe Racers**.

This in from Tony McGrail...

"Delta Tree (my alter ego blues / rock band) played around 20 local gigs last year, during which I was asked if I knew of any funk bands to play Dukes in Christchurch during August. I didn't, but it seemed like an excellent call so the **Funkaholics** were born. Out came the Stevie Wonder and James Brown songbooks, those southern Little Feat funk riffs laced with some Earth Wind and Fire, Chic and Gap Band covers. We try to climb out of the seventies trenches with some Chillii-pepper funk. Prince and Run DMC's "Walk this way", all once described as "Heavy groove funk" and "Hendrix meets Nile Rogers". We even have a few original songs in there which could be huge hits if we still lived in the seventies(!?) Should the punters prefer to riot rather than dance, our twenty odd funk songs can be supplemented with one or two Who, (Fooled again) , Led Zep, (Rock'n'Roll) or Hendrix tunes, usually reserved for our Delta Tree show. The Funkaholics are Tony McGrail on vox and guitar, young Alberto Pastorious on slap thunder bass and local legend stickman and lady killer Dean Wrigler who plays a substantial DW drum kit." Catch them if you can at Dukes in Christchurch on Sat January 23rd , The Spotted Cow Poole Quay on Sat 6th Feb and Penn Hill Central on Sat 27th Feb (All free entry, 9pm starts). Don't forget the **Dukes Blues Jam** on Thurs 4th Feb, hosted by Tony and his trusty cohorts with all and sundry invited to get up and jam. Entry is free and the backline is provided.

Mr Kyps has once again come up trumps this month with a eclectic mix of music. Of the tribute bands here during February, may I draw your attention to **Stipe**, the REM tribute outfit that recently performed in front of their inspiration, Michael Stipe on BBC's The One Show. You can find a clip of the performance via the Kyps website. A faithful reproduction of the vocals, and Peter Bucks distinctive guitar, can be experienced on Friday 5th. **Never The Bride** return to Kyps on the 14th. "Nikki Lamborn has the best female rock voice since Janis Joplin and I know what I'm talking about, I knew Janis." Roger Daltrey.
